

***Definition of exposure (less than 6 feet longer than 15 minutes)**

<p>1. If you have any of the following symptoms:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fever (100.4 or greater) • Cough • Shortness of breath • Nasal congestion • Loss of smell/taste • Sore throat • UNEXPLAINED headache, body aches, chills, excessive fatigue 	<p>Do not report to school. Stay home and isolate. Call Meghan Buchanan* and your PCP as soon as possible. If you had a definite exposure* to a positive person or you were in contact with someone that is PUI - Person Under Investigation.</p> <p>AND You <u>have no</u> symptoms.</p> <p>AND You are up-to-date on your vaccinations, <u>including</u> having received a booster vaccine if eligible (check eligibility at https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/vaccines/booster-shot.html#when-you-can-get-booster)</p> <p>OR You have tested positive for COVID-19 in the past 90 days</p>	<p>You may report to school, wearing a well-fitting mask. Call Meghan Buchanan* to let her know.</p> <p>**Watch for symptoms and wear a mask for 10 days.</p> <p>**If you develop symptoms, go/stay home right away and call Meghan Buchanan*.</p>	<p>Call your PCP to arrange for testing 5 days after exposure, do a home test, or check the state website for available testing facilities</p> <p>https://www.mass.gov/info-details/about-COVID-19-testing#where-can-i-get-a-test?</p> <p>**Those who tested positive for COVID-19 within the past 90 days do not need to be tested.</p>
<p>b. If you had a definite exposure* to a positive person or you were in contact with someone that is PUI - Person Under Investigation.</p> <p>AND You <u>have no</u> symptoms.</p> <p>AND You are unvaccinated or eligible for a booster but have not received it (check eligibility at https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/vaccines/booster-shot.html#when-you-can-get-booster)</p>	<p>Do not report to school, stay home and quarantine for at least 5 full days. Wear a well-fitting mask if you must be around others in your home. Call Meghan Buchanan* and your PCP as soon as possible. (Contact your faculty as well to inform them of your absence).</p> <p>** Watch for symptoms and wear a mask for 10 days.</p> <p>**If you develop symptoms, get tested right away and call Meghan Buchanan*.</p>	<p>Call your PCP to arrange for testing 5 days after exposure, do a home test, or check the state website for available testing facilities</p> <p>https://www.mass.gov/info-details/about-COVID-19-testing#where-can-i-get-a-test?</p>

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Return to school criteria:

#1 Symptomatic with positive COVID-19 test: Student may be cleared to return to school on day 6 after the onset of symptoms, if fever free for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medicines and symptoms have improved. Continue to wear a well-fitting mask through day 10.

#2 Asymptomatic with positive COVID-19 test: Student may be cleared to return to school on day 6 after the day the test was taken. Continue to wear a well-fitting mask through day 10. If student develops symptoms, see #1 above.

#3- Immuno-compromised: Student may be cleared 10-20 days from onset of symptoms as advised by their PCP.
