



Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (CRRSAA – HEERF I, II & III) Final Report

On April 24, 2020, Signature Healthcare Brockton Hospital School of Nursing (SH/BHSON) signed and returned to the U.S. Department of Education the Certification and Agreement for Emergency Financial Aid. As required by Section 18004(c) of the CARES Act, SH/BHSON agreed to use no less than fifty percent of the funds received to provide emergency grants to students for expenses related to the disruption of campus operations due to COVID-19 (including eligible expenses under a student’s cost of attendance such as food, housing, course materials, technology, health care, and child care).

Total Amount of Funds Received

To date, SH/BHSON has received \$544,635 to distribute as direct emergency grants to students per the school’s Certification and Agreement.

For the HEERF I, SH/BHSON identified students who submitted a 2019-20 Institutional Student Information Record (ISIR) and that were meeting satisfactory academic progress requirements during the applicable award year as eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants to Students under Section 18004(a)(1) of the CARES Act.

For the HEERF II and III, SH/BHSON identified the neediest students based on their 2020-21 or 2021-2022 ISIR and that were meeting satisfactory academic progress requirements during the applicable award year as eligible to receive Emergency Financial Aid Grants under Section 204 of the Corona Virus Relief and Response Appropriation Act (CRRSAA).

Per the CRRSAA guidance, SH/BHSON also decided to award students who did not complete an ISIR receive a nominal amount.
